## WHY LIVED EXPERIENCE?

- Over many years, the impacts of research on practice/reallife settings have been limited due to the lack of involving lived experience
- It can take **17 years** for research evidence to be implemented in clinical practice
- Demystifies the research process
- Skills development, research and training opportunities
- Empowering people to use their experience for a positive impact




